1. How did the film confirm or contradict your preconceptions of China you wrote above? How did the film affect your perspective on how goods are manufactured in China?

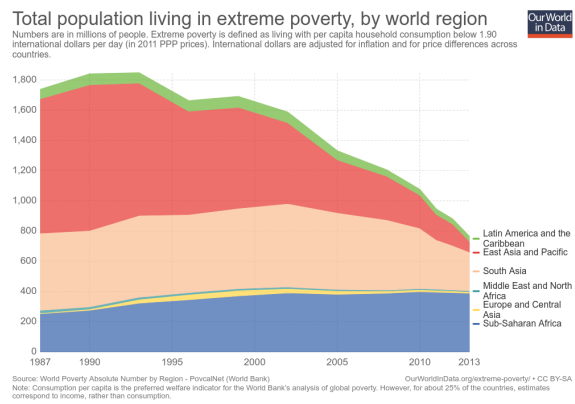
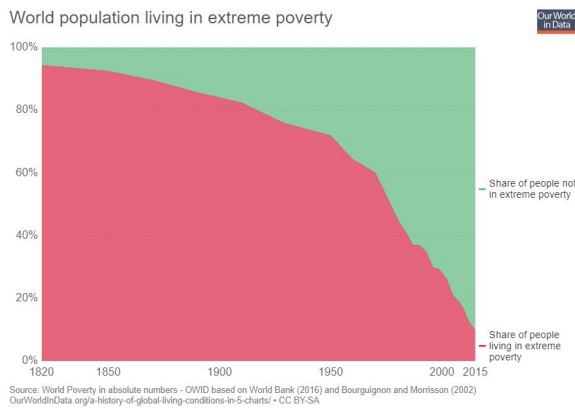
2. How effective was the film's portrait of a single family in illustrating the social and familial trauma experienced by China's millions of migrant workers?
